The International Association of Military Geosciences invites you to share your research, practice, and experiences in military geoscience at the 15th International Conference on Military Geosciences (ICMG24), hosted by the Faculty of Military Sciences at Stellenbosch University, which will be held in Somerset West at the <u>Lord Charles Hotel and Conference Centre</u> from 9 to 14 June 2024. A post-conference battlefield tour (15 to 20 June 2024) to various selected South African battlefields, scenic sites, and interesting places in the Western Cape area will close the conference.

The theme of the conference will be: Unmasking the change and continuity in the nature and character of military operations.

With this deliberate broad theme, the organisers aim to host a conference celebrating the diversity of research avenues explored by Military Geoscientists, as well as the impact this research has on military activities in the broadest possible sense. Considering the current military events in the world, this conference presents a major opportunity to devote time to presentations specifically related to the conflict between Russia and Ukraine.

APPROACH FOR THE ICMG24

The approach from the ICMG 2024 Organising Committee is to bring in new elements compared to previous conferences. This will be the first international **hybrid conference** in military geosciences to attract (in-person and virtual) military geoscientists from around the globe. In addition, invitations will be sent to various national and international higher institutions and military organisations/academies to attract a wider audience (including geoscience practitioners and students).

- Presentations from distinguished international and South African scholars and researchers.
- Two field trips are planned during the conference, namely a visit to the Naval Base and Institute for Maritime Technology (IMT-ARMSCOR) in Simon's Town, and a half-day excursion to Robben Island – a place of isolation where Nelson Mandela was imprisoned for 18 years.
- A welcoming function on Sunday evening and a conference dinner on Tuesday evening (all lunches and coffee breaks are included).
- The five-day post-conference field excursion will include visits to the greater Cape Town Metropolitan area, Franschhoek, Cederberg region, Saldanha Bay, and Buffelsfontein Game and Nature Reserve.

ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

We welcome submissions of abstracts (1-2 pages) in English, following the ICMG24 Abstract template, available on the ICMG24 webpage (Abstracts and Publications tab). Each submission will undergo a thorough peer review process conducted by academics and experts in the field. The review will evaluate various criteria, including scientific originality, relevance to the community, accurate documentation of prior work, clarity of presentation, technical accuracy, and language proficiency.

Authors of accepted abstracts will have the honour of presenting their work in English at the ICMG24 conference. The presentation format may include either an oral presentation or a poster session. It is important to note that the presenting author must complete the conference registration process and payment to secure their participation. The last date for **abstract submission is 30 April 2024**.

PUBLICATIONS

Accepted abstracts that have been revised to address reviewer comments will be published in the Abstract Proceedings ICMG24. Additionally, after submission and approval of the abstracts, authors will be given the option to express their interest in having their abstracts considered for one of the publication opportunities. Should they choose to participate, authors will be required to expand their abstracts into full journal papers/book chapters. These submissions will undergo a double-blind peer review process before being considered for publication in one of the ICMG24 publication options: *Springer Volume, SUN MeDIA, or Scientia Military Special Edition*.

The final publications are anticipated to take place in 2025.
